*52 volunteers worked at five project sites
45 bags of trash removed and approximately 9 miles of land treated*

Projects & Outcomes

Hope Valley T-Post Removal

- Approximately 155 T-posts were removed from the Hope Valley meadow: 81 T-posts were removed around Hope Valley Project Site 1, and approximately 75 T-posts were removed from the meadow edge in partnership with California Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Grover Hot Springs State Park Vegetation Management

- Vegetation removal and tree thinning was completed on a half-acre area resulting in a pile of debris to be chipped by California State Parks. Work was focused on trees three inches in diameter or smaller at the base.

Faith Valley Meadow Restoration

- 1 Beaver Dam Analog installed

West Fork Carson River and Dispersed Camping Areas Cleanup

- 20 bags of trash (~ 90 lbs.) and approximately 5 lbs. of recyclables collected along a 1.5-mile stretch in Woodfords Canyon

Adopt-A-Highway Cleanup

- 25 bags of trash (~ 100 lbs.) collected along 7 miles of Highways 88 and 89 through Hope Valley
