#### **Projects & Outcomes**

### Adopt-A-Highway Cleanups

• 11 bags of trash (~ 110 lbs.) and approximately 5 lbs. of recyclables collected along 6.5 miles of Highway 89

## Faith Valley Dispersed Camping Area Cleanup

• 1 bag of trash (~25 lbs.) and approximately 1 lb. of recyclables collected within 10 acres of Faith Valley

### Mud Lake Road Cleanup

 22.5 cubic yards of trash and approximately 3 lbs. of recyclables collected within 0.75 acres along Mud Lake Road

### West Fork Carson River and Dispersed Camping Areas Cleanup

 13 bags of trash (~ 170 lbs.) and approximately 2 lbs. of recyclables collected along a 2-mile stretch in Woodfords Canyon
